OC VIBE TOUR





My staff attended a tour of OCVIBE, a \$5 billion project now under construction around the Honda Center in Anaheim. It is an incredible project.

This 100 acre mixed use project includes three miles of walkable trails traversing 20 acres of open space and connecting to dining and destinations, including a planned outdoor public art gallery. OCVibe will also build 1,500 residential units, two hotels, a concert venue, and more than one million square feet of office space.

On April 25, Love Yorba Linda hosted its annual city-wide day of service, bringing together neighbors, businesses, schools, and organizations to make a meaningful difference in the community.
